This funding will be used to


- Maintain Year 3 National Assessment Program – Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN) Writing at Mean **449.7 (above Australian Average)**
- Improve Year 5 NAPLAN Writing from Mean **441.6 to 464.6 (Australian Average)**
- Maintain Year 3 NAPLAN Writing Upper two-bands at **55.5% (above Australian Average)**
- Improve Year 5 NAPLAN Writing Upper two-bands from **0% to 13.8% (Australian Average)**

Our initiatives include


- Purchasing release time for teachers to embed high-yield teaching strategies (including data analysis and moderation) in curriculum
- Purchasing Information and communication Technology (ICT) equipment to support teachers with providing instruction across the curriculum and ICT
- Purchase teacher-aide time to provide literacy intervention for programs for students who are not achieving school benchmark levels

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Purchasing 36 days release time across four teachers for data analysis, planning and moderation days with a focus on writing– \$15 120
- Purchase ICT equipment to support teachers with providing instruction across the curriculum and ICT - \$6 147
- Purchase Teacher-aide time for 48 weeks of 10 hours per week for intervention strategies for students not reaching benchmark levels - \$18 313
